FROM PATTY DEBIASIO*Dear Friends,**I want to thank you for the wonderful farewell gathering on the feast of St. Thomas More last week. Thank you for all of your prayers, cards, gifts, special foods and cakes and well wishes. The "special sprinkling blessing" imparted by all those at the Liturgy over me is one that I will take with me and hold in my heart and memory always!**I have been so blessed by getting to know so many of you. Once again, four years in Indiana (just like in the late '70's when I was a student at IUP) has been a growing time for me. I have been molded, pruned, blessed and nurtured, and have learned much from my role in ministry. Father Willie has been a good mentor, pastor and friend. I hope that my work here, under his leadership, has glorified God and has been what the Parish has needed to help all grow in relationship with Jesus, the Good Shepherd.**These four years in my own personal life have presented a myriad of joys, challenges, delights and sorrows. You, my St. Thomas More Family, have been there to help me celebrate many of life's milestones like my 50th birthday, my sons' graduation from high school, transitions to the "empty nest" for my husband, Mike and me, and God's miracles of healing. Many of you have prayed with me and for me in the last few years through job uncertainties and new employment for Mike, health issues and challenges, and times of grief as I mourned the death of my grandmother, father, and last fall, the death of my dear friend, Carol.**All of us face challenges on the Journey and it is good that our Faith unites us as the Body of Christ to love and support one another and rejoice in God's Plan of Eternal Life. My gratitude goes beyond what any words can express.**As many of you are aware, I have not even attempted to verbally express my gratitude; I still cannot speak about this transitional time without welling up with tears of many emotions. For me, to be a catechist – one called to Echo God's Word- is a humbling experience; one that is an honor and a privilege. It has been an honor and a privilege to share God's Word in so many ways with all of you. One way in particular, Good Shepherd Catechesis, is a treasure for me from God. I hope in some way, I can continue to share in this work; it is in working in the Atrium with these precious children that God feeds my soul.**It has been through much prayer and discernment that I have come to the decision to resign from a position that I love, with people that I love, and to pursue a career closer to home. As Father Willie has mentioned, the lengthy "time on the road" during my daily commute between Jeannette and Indiana has taken its toll on me (and my family) in many ways. That, coupled with my desire to be an elementary teacher since the age of three, has drawn me forward on the path to something that God "knitted me in my mother's womb" to carry out. But now, thirty years later as I embark on my teaching vocation again, I am even more aware of the challenge I face -- preaching the Good News of Jesus Christ often without words.**When I hear Chuck Potthast's song "We Come to the Table" I will always have fond memories of STMUP and recall how this parish family knows how to lift up their voices in praise and thanksgiving to God.
